Road Safety with Fender



Along the roads, you will notice all kinds of road signs which warn you about dangers, help you know where you are or how to drive.

They sometimes tell you what speed is allowed, how sharp the bend in the road is, if there are road works ahead, whether you have to slow down and so on.



Circular signs give orders - they must be followed to stay within the law. Circles with a red border tell you what you must not do.



Blue circles usually give a positive instruction, such as 'roundabout ahead'.



Triangular signs warn you about the road layout or any hazards that lie ahead, such as sharp bends. They almost always have a red border.



Rectangular road signs inform. Blue rectangular signs give information on motorways, green signs direct you on primary roads, while white signs give directions on minor roads. Rectangular signs can also show bus lanes.



See what signs you can find when you are riding in a car and ask the driver what they mean!

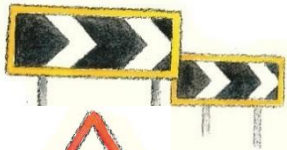
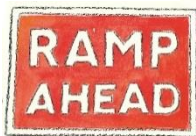

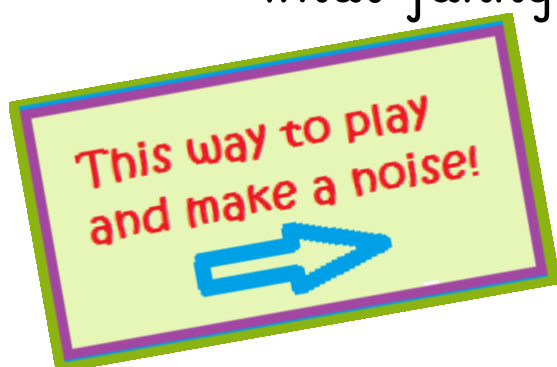
When Dan and Fender were driving to the Seal Sanctuary, they had to keep going slow as there were lots of signs on the roads.
