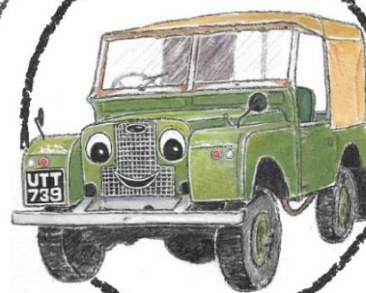


Art Work with Landy

Find and make props for telling and acting

The Landy Story

- Make stick puppets of ducks, sheep, hens, Molly, pig Tractor, Landy etc. Paste the pictures onto card and cut them out. Then tape the cut-outs onto lolly sticks.
- Molly's orange ball, hay, wood, grain sack, toy tools, hooter, cap for James the farmer.
- Use a cardboard box to make a simple Landy and paint his face and paint UTT 739 on it (this can be done for Tractor and Pickup as well).
- Make masks of lamb, piglets, ducks, calf, hen etc out of plate plates or papier mache (there are lots of ideas on the internet and youtube).
- Blue T shirt for Jack.
- A game or toys that are related to the story, like farm animals.
- Pictures of related places or events.
- Paper and crayons to write or draw own stories.
- Related colouring pages.
- Written suggestions and items to help act out the story.
- A fact book to learn more about situations or elements of the story.
