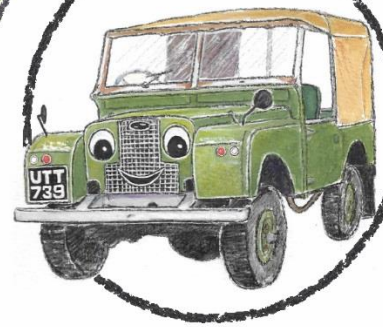


Learning with Landy

- Draw a mind map.
- Research your storyline.
- Plan the structure of your story; beginning, build up, problem, resolution.
- plan to use expanded noun phrases, relative clauses etc.

Other classroom activities:

- Oral retelling of the Landy story.
- Written retelling of the story.
- Deconstruct the story.
- Talk about the main characters.
- Identification of language used eg nouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs, conjunctions.



Role play of the story -
with the children reading different characters parts.

Write a song or poem about Landy and friends.

Write a short play from the book.

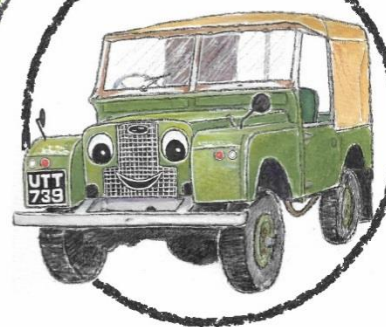


Jack went into the kitchen to pack a picnic. He and Landy were looking forward to spending a lovely day in the woodlands.
